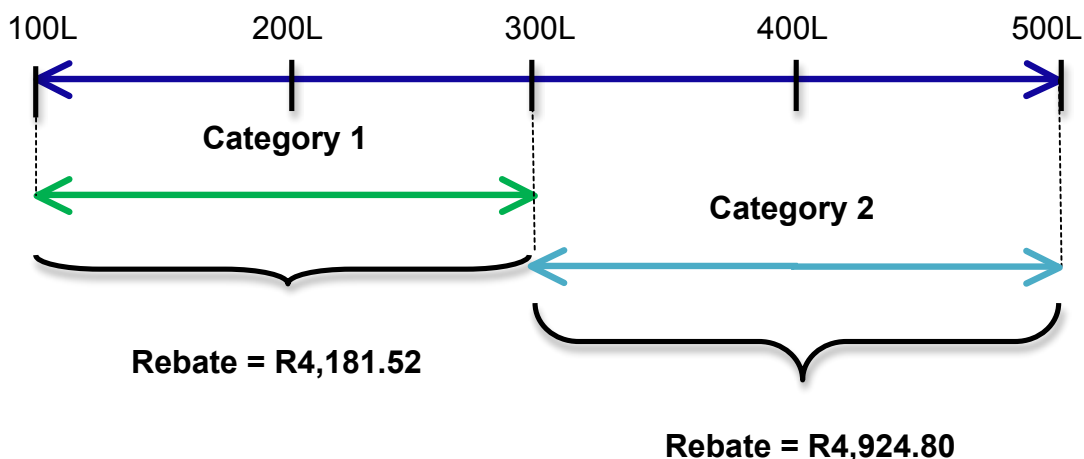


With electricity shortages becoming an increasing concern in South Africa, Eskom is taking measures to encourage the efficient use of energy in order to help close the supply-demand gap. Where a geyser element uses one unit of electrical energy to produce one unit of heat energy, a heat pump converts just one unit of electrical energy into more than THREE units of heat energy thus making it a very efficient way of heating water.

The purpose of the residential heat pump rebate programme is to provide financial assistance to the residential market by enabling individual customers to purchase energy efficient heat pumps at a rebated cost. Not only can you benefit from the Eskom rebate but you will also enjoy long term energy savings.

Who qualifies for the rebate? The rebate is open to individual home owners, game lodges, guest houses, hotels and anyone who currently uses one or more geysers provided their individual capacity does not exceed 500 litres. Rebates only apply when you are retrofitting or replacing existing electrical element geysers.

ESKOM REBATE STRUCTURE:

In the above diagram you'll note that the rebate is split into two categories. **Category 1** (tank sizes 100-300 litres) qualifies for a **R4,181.52** rebate and **Category 2** (tank sizes 301-500 litres) qualifies for a **R4,924.80** rebate.

How and where do I get my rebated heat pump? Customers can buy heat pumps at the rebated cost from accredited, registered suppliers on the Eskom rebate programme, of which SIRAC is one. The price you pay is the discounted amount, your supplier (SIRAC) will get the rebate from Eskom.
